

Volunteering at The Hawkevale Trust

- Volunteering forms part of The Hawkevale Trusts' Personal Support Services.
- The Hawkevale Trust seeks volunteers to visit people with developmental disabilities, mainly in the Perth metropolitan area, but also in regional Western Australia.
- Volunteers visit Hawkevale Trust clients at least once every two months to provide them with support and advocate their needs on their behalf. This includes monitoring their health, social activities, accommodation, finances, personal hygiene and overall lifestyle.
- Volunteers need to have a general interest in the needs and aspirations of people with developmental disabilities and be responsible, committed and reliable, with respect for client confidentiality, and tactful and sensitive to clients' needs.
- Volunteers receive full training, as well as a full introduction to the Hawkevale Trust, and to the specific disabled person they will be visiting and advocating for, and full ongoing support.
