

The Hawkevale Trust

- The Hawkevale Trust is a not-for-profit charitable organisation established in 1989. It helps dozens of Western Australian families secure the well-being and futures of their disabled loved ones.
- The Hawkevale Trust was originally formed under the auspices of Activ Foundation and continues to work alongside Activ and also in collaboration with agencies including the Disability Services Commission and Department for Housing and Works.
- The Hawkevale Trust is managed by a Board comprising of elected and appointed members, plus two paid Executives and a team of volunteers.
- The Trust provides a means for parents or carers of people with a developmental disability to make plans and provisions when they are no longer able to look after them. The role of the Trust is to prepare for and eventually implement those plans, including accommodation, financial security and overall quality of life.
- The Trust receives no direct Government funding. Financial support is obtained through grants, donations and bequests. In the long-term, The Hawkevale Trust aims to be self-funding.
